what is P-EBT exactly?

Pandemic EBT provides financial assistance to replace school meals that were missed during the 2020/2021 school year due to COVID-19 school closures or modified schedules. P-EBT can be used in grocery stores and other retailers that accept EBT cards to buy nutritious food items for your child(ren).

Why Am I Getting This?

The Alabama Department of Human Resources (DHR) is working with the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) to make P-EBT cards available to families that qualify for P-EBT. If your child(ren) attended a school participating in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and received free or reduced meals for breakfast or lunch, and subsequently missed these meals due to school closures, then your child may be eligible for P-EBT. If your child receives a P-EBT card, but your family doesn't want the benefits, you should simply destroy the card or return it to - P.O. Box 81129, Austin, TX 78708-1129.

What do I need to do?

- a) Verify the mailing address of your child(ren) with the school they attend.
 - Please submit your full address including apartment and lot numbers if applicable.
 - Failure to provide the school with your correct mailing address may delay and prevent the delivery of your child(ren)s P-EBT card.
- b) Verify all personal contact numbers for the parent or guardian.
- c) If your income reduced due to COVID-19, your child may now be eligible for this program. Contact your school to complete a Free and Reduced-Price Meal Lunch Form by March 31, 2021
