Presence of a parent or legal guardian is required to enroll a student.
TO ENROLL YOU MUST BE A RESIDENT OF TARRANT

TO PROVE RESIDENCY IN THE CITY OF TARRANT YOU MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

ONE (1) OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS MUST BE PROVIDED YEARLY:

STEP 1: (You will need one of the following)

- Current property **TAX Bill** of Tarrant Residence
- **Current Monthly Mortgage Statement**
- **Current** signed and dated **LEASE** with names of all who live at this Tarrant address.



STEP 2: (You will need one of the following)

- **Two current utility (electric, gas, or water) bills** showing your name and address. No cell phone bills, cable bills, disconnection notice, or garbage bill.
- **Current state or federal income tax statement.**
- **Current state or federal assistance verification.**

PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTATION YEARLY, UNLESS STATED OTHERWISE:

STEP 3:

- Certificate of Residence (everybody/every YEAR)
- **VALID (CURRENT) Driver's license for Custodial Parent(s)/Legal Custodial Guardian(s) (Copy yearly)**
- Official (Court) current **custody documents** (if applicable)



Step 4: For first time enrollment only

- ***Original birth certificate**
- ***Original social security card**
- **CURRENT (Up-to-date) blue immunization form**

*Disclosure of your child's social security number (SSN), birth certificate and your current driver's license is voluntary. If you select not to provide a SSN, a temporary identification number will be generated and utilized instead. Your child's SSN is being requested for use in conjunction with enrollment in school as provided in Ala. Admin. Code §290-3-1-.02(2)(b)(2). It will be used as a means of identification in the statewide student management system. Parents are responsible for giving accurate and up to date information regarding legal addresses and contact information to school officials. Giving false information to public officials in the performance of his or her duty is a violation of the Criminal Code of Alabama §13A-10-109(a) and punishable by a fine of \$500.00 and up to 90 days in jail.
